## What We Do

We partner with local quality early learning centers and provide a *HAND-UP* for hard-working families who are not receiving government pre-K assistance, and who are struggling to pay for preschool tuition for their child(ren). For families who qualify based on financial criteria, we will pay <u>\$160 per month</u> per qualifying child directly to the early learning center to help offset a portion of the family's monthly tuition for each child from birth until they qualify for VPK.

## **How Applicants Apply**

Share this flyer with your early learning center. If they are already an approved, participating center, they can show you our income eligibility chart and give you a preapproval form to complete and email to us. We will then send you the full application to complete if you're pre-approved.

If your center is NOT already participating with us, we'll be happy to talk with the director about our program and show them how <u>easy</u> it is to offer our help to <u>all</u> of their potentially qualifying families, and to you!
